



## Who We Are



**APICDA** (Aleutian Pribilof Island Community Development Association) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit incorporated in the state of Alaska. Our charitable purpose is to develop stable local economies in our member communities of Akutan, Atka, False Pass, Nelson Lagoon, Nikolski and St. George.

Our focus on community development sets us apart from the typical seafood company. The region's seafood resources have provided for families in our communities through many generations. By doing business with APICDA, you assist our work to better the lives of people in the communities throughout the Aleutian and Pribilof Islands.

### APICDA Seafood Operations:

**Atka Pride Seafoods (APS)**— APS is located in Atka, halfway between Tokyo and Seattle, and processes sustainably harvested halibut and sablefish from the most productive fishing grounds in the world.

**Bering Pacific Seafoods (BPS)**— BPS is located in False Pass and processes seafood from both the Bering Sea and Pacific Ocean. It produces the highest quality wild Alaska salmon in the world. Other products include halibut, sablefish and Pacific cod.

**Cannon Fish Company (CFC)**—Jointly owned and operated 80% by APICDA and 20% by Atxam Corporation, Cannon Fish is a value-added seafood processing and marketing company. CFC focuses on sourcing and marketing premium finfish from around the globe to complement the premium Alaska fish sustainably harvested by our Aleutian fishermen.

### Community Development Quota (CDQ)

APICDA is one of six CDQ groups. The CDQ program allocates a percentage of all Bering Sea and Aleutian Islands quotas for groundfish, halibut and crab to eligible communities. The program's intent is to provide economically disadvantaged communities in western Alaska with the opportunity to generate capital to develop stable local economies based upon the fishing industry.
