- 5) Photos must be taken in the APICDA region: Atka, Akutan, False Pass, Nelson Lagoon, Nikolski, St. George and Unalaska.
- 6) Photos should portray images that depict community life: highlighting wildlife, scenic views, Alaska Native traditions, rural Alaska life, fishing and anything else that might best portray the spirit of the APICDA communities.

All photos submitted will be considered for the APICDA 2021 calendar. Each of the photos selected for each item will be awarded a cash prize. *Employees are encouraged to participate but are not eligible for cash prize.*
